GENERAL INFORMATION

Location

Youth camp is located on the Beaver Creek Reserve, 12 miles from Eau Claire, WI.

Eligibility

District Five youth ages 9-15 (must be 9 by first day of camp) and youth from other Sons of Norway Districts. Sons of Norway affiliation, while not required, is strongly encouraged, but it is not a pre-requisite for camp attendance.

Visitors

Visitors are NOT ALLOWED during camp. Early pick-up at camp is not permitted, except in the case of an emergency.

Payment

A \$100.00 non-refundable deposit and application fee is payable with application. This amount is applied to full tuition cost. Please see **REGISTRATION BASICS** to left with payment information.

Matching Funds

Contact your lodge secretary for information about matching funds. The match is currently one to one. (If a local lodge contributes \$150.00, that amount is matched by the 5th District. If lodge donates less than \$150.00, that amount is also matched.) The request for matching funds must be postmarked by May 17, 2022. Return your application to Youth Director. (See **LEADERSHIP TEAM** section to left for contact info.)

Final payments for camp are due no later than June 17, 2022. Late payments pose a concern for everyone at camp. Please take care of your family's balance soon after receiving your reconciliation sheet. The first day of camp is July 17, 2022.

Facilities
